## PART 1

- 1) Identify five things that you can gain from studying about families.

- 4) Explain what are *Values*? How are they learned in North American culture?
  
- 5) List and explain four different golden rules to help you develop your *Value system*.
  
- 6) What is meant by the term *Culture*?

- 7) Explain how *cultures* are the same or different.
- 8) What is meant by the term *Ethnocentrism*? Why can it be a negative thing?
- 9) What is meant by the phrase “*socialization process*”?
- 10) Explain *Maslow’s Hierarchal* theory for families.

- 11) Which of the *needs* that a family meets is the most important? Why?
- 12) Explain which is more important in your opinion when people of different cultures live in the same community: Blending the cultures together or preserving them separately?
- 13) What might happen to an individual who is not properly socialized as a child?
